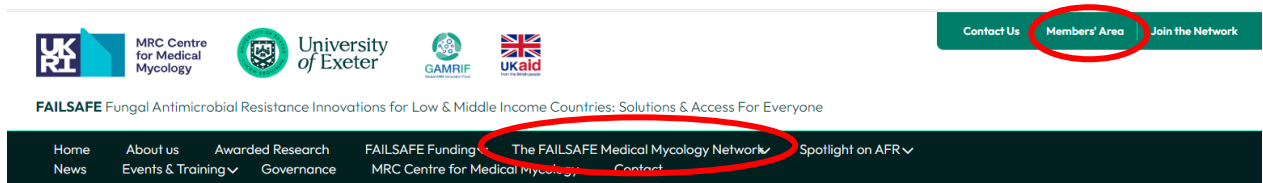

How to login to the FAILSAFE Medical Mycology Network for the first time

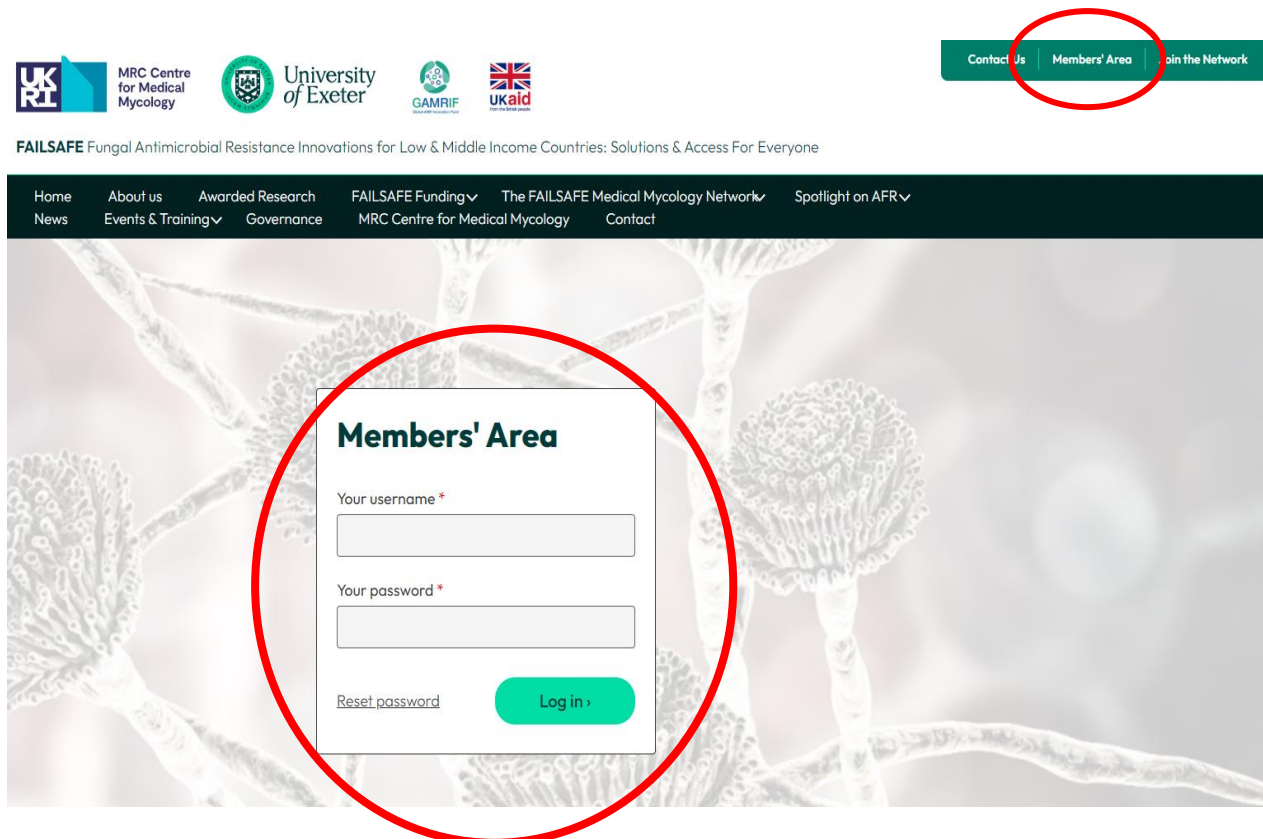
1. Navigate to the login page of the FAILSAFE website
