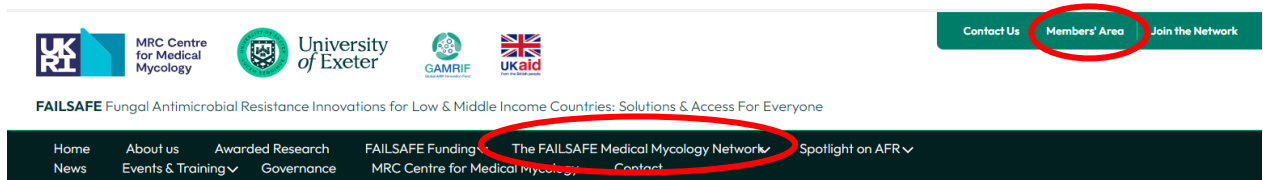


How to update your FAILSAFE Medical Mycology Network Profile including Ecosystem details

Updating a Current Profile

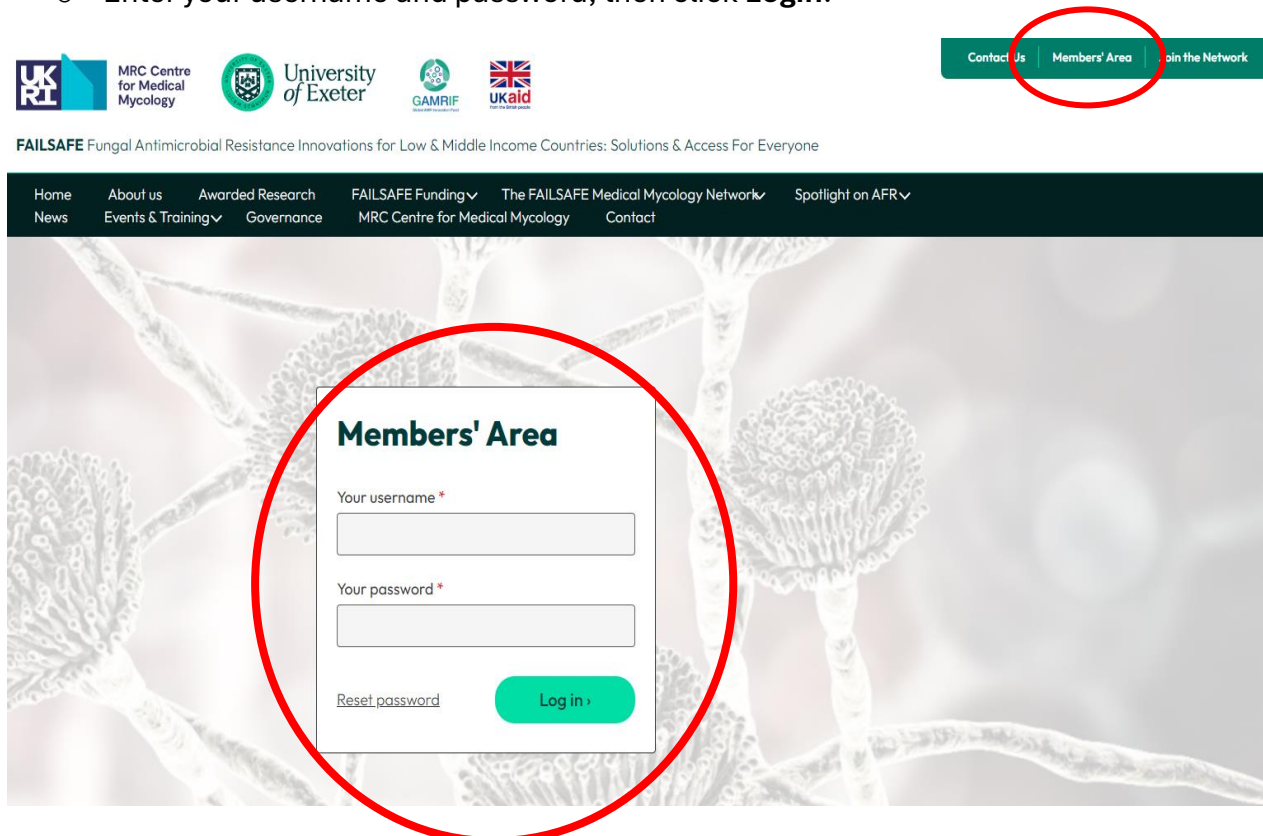
1. Navigate to the login page of the FAILSAFE website
